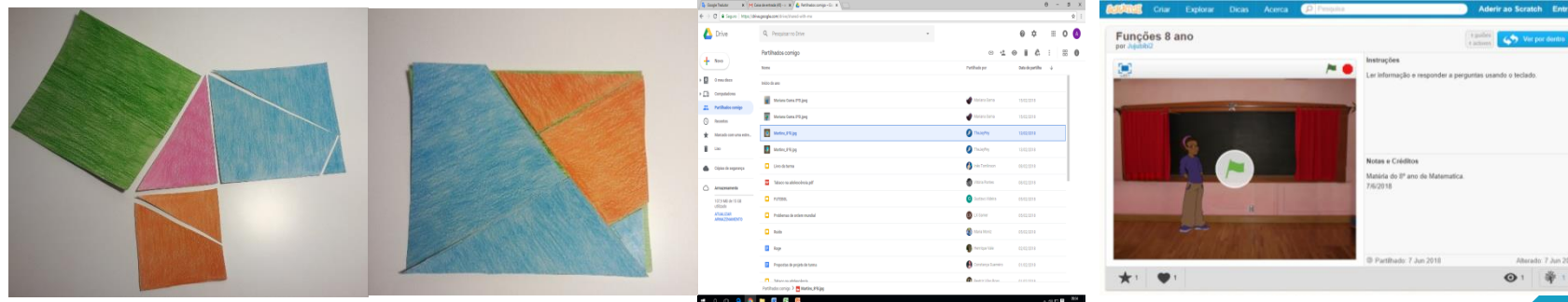


What did you (or your students) like the most?

What did you learn from your experience?
