MORE ABOUT THE EUROPEAN CODING INITIATIVE

In 2014 European Schoolnet was invited by DG Connect to coordinate an industry-driven coalition and set up a neutral platform for the promotion of teaching and learning programming and coding. As a result of this call to action, the **European Coding Initiative** was established, bringing together key industry players in the ICT field.

In October 2014 Former Vice President of the European Commission Neelie Kroes launched officially the Initiative and the [all you need is {C<3DE} - www.allyouneediscode.eu](#) website for **students, teachers** and **adults** who are looking to try out coding for the first time, and to discover what opportunities it can open up for them.

One year later, the funding members of the programme - **Facebook, Liberty Global, Microsoft, Samsung** and **SAP** - are intensifying their effort and commitment. Vice-President Ansip and Commissioner Oettinger have also endorsed the initiative within the framework of the [Grand Coalition for Digital Jobs](#).
